Dear retreat participants,

From September 29, 2007 to September 30, 2007 at Blue Springs Scout Reserve (please see attached map), there will be a retreat for young adults as well as highschool animators organized and led by the Catholic youth movement, Youth Teams of Our Lady. Give the following a careful read-through.

A retreat is meant to be a time of prayer, a time spent in communion with God. Please do not bring cell phones, walkmans, radios, CD players, videogames or magazines. If you bring any of these items, they will be confiscated and returned to you at the end of the retreat. Possession of drugs and alcohol in the building or on the grounds of the retreat home is strictly forbidden.

Please bring only the following: a sleeping bag, warm clothing, shoes you can wear indoors, personal hygiene stuff, as well as a Bible, Rosary, pens and paper.

You must have received the sacrament of confirmation in order to participate in the retreat. Also keep in mind that as a retreat participant, you will be expected to take part in the entire retreat program. If you won't participate, you will be asked to go home.

Meals will be prepared right at the retreat home, so you don't need to bring food. You must eat three meals a day (no dieting on retreat!).

The cost of the retreat is \$ 45 if paid by Sept 26, \$65 if paid later. The full payment in cash or cheque or online (made out to Youth Teams of Our Lady) is due ASAP (by Wednesday September 26) to Ania Straszak. BLUE SPRINGS DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

If you are coming from:

Toronto (GTA)

Take the 401 West past Mississauga and past Oakville until you get to Milton.

Take regional Hwy #25 north from Milton for about 10 minutes until you get to side road # 25

Turn left on side road #25.

Follow side road #25 west for about 5 minutes until you reach 6th Line Nassagaweya.

Turn right and drive for about 3 minutes. Blue springs main gate #14014 will be on your right hand side

London, Kitchener-Waterloo, Cambridge

Take the 401 East past Guelph until you get to the Guelph Line at Campbellville.

Take Guelph Line north from Campbellville for about 10 minutes. Turn right at side road # 25.

Take side road # 25 east for about 5 minutes until you reach 6th Line Nassagaweya.

Turn left and go north for about 3 minutes. Blue springs main gate #14014 will be on your right hand side

Hamilton, Burlington, Niagara Region

From the QEW/403 take the Guelph Line North.

Continue north of the 401 on Guelph Line.

After 10 minutes of driving north of the 401 on Guelph Line you will reach side road #25.

Turn right on side road # 25. Drive east for about 5 minutes until you reach 6th Line Nassagaweya.

Turn left and go north for about 3 minutes. Blue springs main gate #14014 will be on your right hand side.

Guelph

Take Hwy. #7 east to Rockwood

Turn right at the traffic light in Rockwood and proceed east on Hwy#7 for about 5 minutes until you get to 6th Line Nassagaweya.

6th Line Nassagaweya.

Turn right on 6th Line Nassagaweya and go south for 2 minutes. Blue springs main gate #14014 will be on your left

Georgetown

Take Hwy. #7 west through Acton.

Turn right at the traffic light in Acton and follow the curve of the road left (you're still on Hwy#7).

Drive for about 3 minutes until you get to 6th Line Nassagaweya.

Turn left on 6th Line Nassagaweya and go south for 2 minutes. Blue springs main gate #14014 will be on your left
