Who can attend the meeting?

The International Meeting is for active YTOL members only. YTOLers from Canada must be 16 by July 23rd 2009 to attend. YTOLers who are under the age of 18 as of July 23rd 2009 must be accompanied by a chaperone (see website for Chaperone Guidelines and Procedures). Each participant must have a Canadian passport that is valid until 6 months after you return from your travel. (see website for more information)

Participant duties include:

1. The primary responsibility of the participant is to abide by the code of conduct set out by the organizers of the International Meeting 2009 and by the duties set out in this document.
2. Uphold Canadian law regarding Drug/ Alcohol/ Tobacco. Details can be found in the Chaperone Guidelines and Procedures Document on website.
3. Attending all seminars, workshops, meetings and events as planned by the organizers of the International Meeting 2009
4. Become and stay active in YTOL including helping with fundraising events directly related to the International Meeting.

Active YTOL Member:

- Actively participate in your YTOL Team, i.e. regularly attend monthly meetings, be involved in service projects, and team socials (exceptions will be made for those who willingly want to be active but have no YTOL team in their area)
- Participate by organizing or attending a Retreat – There are four retreats that YTOL is organizing this year: The YA December retreat, a February Animator retreat and two HS March Break retreats.
- Be involved in Fundraising and/or Community Building Events. There are many such events being organized. These events will be posted on the website and in the YTOL newsletter.

* it is the individual responsibility of every active YTOL member to keep themselves informed of the movement's news and events throughout the year. This can be done by communicating with your team animator or a member of the secretariat, visiting the YTOL website and/or reading the YTOL newsletter.

* The secretariat holds the right to use their discretion when presented with an individual's extenuating circumstances. Rest assured that a YTOL member's activeness will not be judged numerically. We hope that this activeness will result from a genuine desire for their own spiritual growth and that of the movement.

Approval Procedure:

1. Register by submitting down payment by November 21st 2008
2. Complete and Submit Registration Form
3. Attach photo copy of valid passport with Registration Form
4. Attend Information sessions and take part in decision making processes
5. Submit remainder of conference payment (mid-late February)

If you are a Chaperoned participant than you must follow the Chaperone Rules and Procedures document which outlines approval procedures from the secretariat.
